Rules Checklist

****NOTE: a 6-credit course can be made up of two 3-credit courses.**

1. Residency requirement: a minimum of 30 credits (5 full courses) including at least half (50 per cent) of the major credits must be completed at York University. **2. Faculty requirement:** a minimum of 18 credits at the 3000 or 4000 level. **3. Graduation requirement:** students must successfully complete (pass) at least 90 credits that meet the Faculty's degree and program requirements with a cumulative grade point average of at least 4.00 (C).
