Degree Progress

- Confirm your degree requirements.
- Review any transfer credits.
- Discuss degree progress.



Course Planning

- Explore program options & change of major.
- Plan your courses for the next academic session.
- Review your course selection.



Academic Issues

- Review academic decisions.
- Discuss academic petitions.
- Verify academic policies, procedures, & regulations.



Course Issues

- Address questions & concerns about a course.

Future Planning

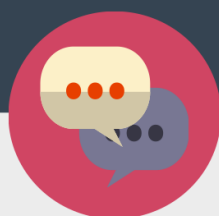
- Discuss graduate school options.

Come Prepared

- Maintain your degree checklist.
- Bring checklist to all appointments.
- Prepare a list of questions & concerns.



Get Involved

- Come prepared for appointments.
- Ask questions, get answers.
- Actively participate in your advising.



Be Informed

- Know your academic standing.
- Enrol in courses during the enrollment period.
- Read policies & procedures.



Check In Regularly
